



Eliminator® Express Layout Blind Instructions

Congratulations on your purchase of the original and #1 choice of professional guides and serious hunters....The Final Approach® Eliminator® Blind.



When you open the box to your new Eliminator, the blind will come somewhat assembled. The backrest should be positioned inside the blind. The gun rest will need minor assembly. You will only need no tools for assembly.

Assembly:

1. Lay out the blind cover (backrest included). Erect the backrest by folding back the upright brace until it meets the back portion of the blind. The backrest is now in its upright position.
2. Locate the remaining 3 pieces of tubing. Assemble these items by placing the ends of the bent tubing into the plastic components on the straight tubes.



3. Place the gun rest into the pockets on the floor and fold the Velcro together. This will hold the gun rest in position to hunt.



When you are ready to transport the blind, lower the upright brace that so the backrest folds flat. Remove the bent tubing from the straight tubing on the gun rest and slide it into the foot pouch. Fold the foot pouch twice towards the backrest and bungee the cover together. The blind can now be carried by the handle or the backpack straps.

Note: Before using your Eliminator Express Blind for the first time, we recommend getting the fabric dirty to permanently eliminate any “shine” the new fabric may have. We suggest the following procedure: With the Blind in its upright position, mix dirt and water in a bucket until it becomes a mud-like substance. Using dirt from the general area that you plan on hunting in will help the blind to blend in to its surroundings. Apply the mud generously to the entire outside of the blind with a broom. Let mixture dry on the cover for at least two hours. Wipe off any excess mud with the broom leaving a dirty residue on the blind.

Washing: Do NOT machine wash or dry! If desired, remove excess dirt and mud from the fabric using a brush and mild soap and the rinse, using COLD water only, from a garden hose. Line Dry!
